Mr Mokgwaro George Molotlegi was born on the 13th May 1936. He was the second son of the late Chief Manotshe James Molotlegi and Mrs Motswere Maria Molotlegi.

He did his primary schooling at Bapong (Wolhulteroskop) and Alexandra Township.

He then proceeded to Kilnerton High School.

Mr Mokgwaro obtained his BA degree at the University of Pennsylvania and his MBA at Howard University in the USA.

After spending eleven years in America he came back home and held his first job at Impala Platinum Mines, Phokeng. A few years later he joined Sun International as Director of Personnel. He left Sun City to start his own business.
